Day 35: Sun 11 February 2024

Theme: Awesome God, The True Promoter

Along the journey of life, we all seek success and promotion from one level to another. Sometime we want it so much that we do not give a second thought to using treacherous means to gain success and promotion. However, as followers of Christ, instead of trying so hard in our strength, wisdom, and connections, our eyes should be on God for success. In Him and through Him, we have the assurance of promotion from glory to glory because God is the ultimate promoter!

Psalm 75:6-7 (NIV)

"No one from the east or the west or from the desert can exalt themselves. It is God who judges: He brings one down, he exalts another."

God wants you to succeed, and in time, He will promote you. His ways surpass human understanding, and His promotions are marked by divine purpose.

In the Bible, we see how God promoted people like Joseph from prison to the palace, and David from being a forgotten and despised shepherd boy to king over Israel. Today, yes, in our day, God can do it again, for all who trust in Him.

God is not bound by earthly systems and structures. He holds the authority to promote us in His timing regardless of our background age, sex or peculiar circumstances. Therefore, trust His plan and timing as you pursue your aspirations.

Application

Prayer Direction

Personal

Jeremiah 29:11

- Pray for your aspirations and goals in 2024. Ask God for wisdom to do His will.
- Pray for patient endurance as you wait for your promotion. Surrender your ambitions to Him knowing that His promotion brings lasting joy and fulfillment.

Family

- Ask God to reveal and align your family to His purpose. Commit your 2024 family goals and ambitions to God.
- Pray for wisdom to steward the plans that God has given your family.
- Pray for divine grace and power to overcome obstacles that stand in the way of your family plans.

Church

- Pray for the 2024 plans that God has given Watoto Church Ministries (celebration growth, church plants, school outreaches, building projects, community care etc)
- Ask God to grant insight to church leaders in the nation to steward the resources entrusted to them for the expansion of God’s Kingdom.

Nation

- Pray for the development plans of our nation. Ask God to give our leaders wisdom to steward the nation’s resources with integrity and diligence for the benefit of the people and for the glory of His name.



Day 36: Mon 12 February 2024

Theme: Awesome God, Our Saviour

Song: "Mighty To Save by Hillsong

Isaiah 43:11 (NIV)

"I, even I, am the Lord, and apart from me, there is no savior."

Titus 3:4-6 (NIV)

"But when the kindness and love of God our Savior appeared, he saved us, not because of righteous things we had done, but because of his mercy. He saved us through the washing of rebirth and renewal by the Holy Spirit, whom he poured out on us generously through Jesus Christ our Savior."

A saviour is a person who rescues, liberates, delivers, and redeems another from danger or difficulty. When we study God's Word, His ultimate redemptive plan unfolds through the person of Jesus, our awesome Saviour. While there are many aspects of our lives that we need to be saved from (sickness, addictions, bondages, demonic attacks, consequences of our bad choices etc), there is one dire need that unites us all. Everybody needs salvation from sin, and nobody can save us apart from our Awesome God.

Romans 6:23 reminds us that the wages of sin is death but God offers us the free gift of eternal life in Christ Jesus, our Lord and Saviour!

Awesome God, Do It Again

Our internal struggles with guilt, shame, and the weight of our sins can be overwhelming. Yet, in tough times, our Awesome God steps in as our mighty Saviour. He does not just rescue us from outside threats but liberates us from the chains within — breaking the bonds of guilt, demolishing the strongholds of shame, and redeeming us from the consequences of our sins.

Reflection

1. In what areas of your life do you recognize the need for God as your Saviour?
2. How can you share the message of salvation with those around you today?

Prayer

Heavenly Father, we thank You for the gift of salvation through Jesus, our awesome Saviour. May Your saving grace permeate every aspect of our lives. Empower us to share the message of redemption with those around us, and may Your transformative love bring salvation to the nations. We pray for your saving power to be made manifest in our struggles, turning them around for our good. In Jesus' name, we pray. Amen.

Prayer Direction

Personal

- Thank God for the gift of eternal life through Jesus; acknowledge Him as your Saviour.
- Confess any sins or struggles you may be facing, and ask for God's saving grace to overcome these struggles (Psalm 19:13).
- Pray for the strength to live a life that honours God (Titus 2:11-14).

Family

- Repent on behalf of your family for ongoing sin. Ask for God's saving grace to overcome sin and live victorious life in Jesus.
- Pray for people in your family that do not know Jesus as their Saviour to receive Him in their lives.

Church

- Thank God for His saving love for the church.
- Pray that God will continue to use the church to fill everything with His presence (Ephesians 1:23).
- Pray that the church will continue to be a place where people experience the saving power of God.

Nation

- Pray for the challenges in your community; seek God's saving intervention to deliver your community from evil bondages (witchcraft, poverty, immorality etc).
- Pray for those in your community who may be searching for a Saviour. Ask God to open their hearts to receive His redemptive love.
- Pray for missionaries and individuals spreading the message of salvation worldwide so that many people will come to know Jesus as the Gospel is preached.



Day 37: Tue 13 February 2024

Theme: Awesome God, Our Sure Foundation

Confidence is the assurance and trust we have in ourselves, others, or a higher power. When we have confidence, we tend to believe in our abilities, decisions, and the support we receive from those around us. Ultimately, however, our confidence should be rooted in our awesome God, who as our source of strength and security, is our sure foundation.

Isaiah 41:10 (ESV)

"Fear not, for I am with you; be not dismayed, for I am your God; I will strengthen you, I will help you, I will uphold you with my righteous right hand."

Prophet Isaiah asserts that God is our constant companion, providing strength and support in every situation. In today's fast-paced and uncertain world, it is easy to feel overwhelmed and insecure. Many of us face daily challenges in our personal lives, careers, and leadership roles. In times of doubt or difficulty, God offers us unwavering confidence and assurance. When we place our trust in Him, we can face each day with boldness and courage, knowing that He is with us every step of the way and we can say to any and every challenge: "I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me..." (Philippians 4:13, NIV).

Prayer Direction

Personal

- Ask God to give you a heart that is confident and steadfast in Him. *"Though an army besiege me, my heart will not fear; though war break out against me, even then I will be confident."* (Psalm 27:3, NIV)

- Pray for strength during times of weakness. *“But he said to me, ‘My grace is sufficient for you, for my power is made perfect in weakness.’ Therefore, I will boast all the more gladly about my weaknesses, so that Christ’s power may rest on me.”* (2 Corinthians 12:9 NIV)
- Ask God for faith to Trust in His plan for your life. *“But blessed is the one who trusts in the Lord, whose confidence is in him.”* (Jeremiah 17:7 NIV)

Families

- Pray for parents to raise their children in a godly way. *“Start children off on the way they should go, and even when they are old they will not turn from it.”* (Proverbs 22:6)
- Pray for your family to have confidence in God’s vision for their lives. *“How good and pleasant it is when God’s people live together in unity!”* (Psalm 133:1NIV)
- Pray for family to have trust in God’s provision. *“And my God will supply every need of yours according to his riches in glory in Christ Jesus.”* (Philippians 4:19 NIV)

Church

- Ask God to give us confidence to share the Gospel with those around us. *“For I am not ashamed of the gospel, because it is the power of God that brings salvation to everyone who believes: first to the Jew, then to the Gentile.”* (Romans 1:16 NIV)
- Pray for believers everywhere to be filled with boldness in ministry. *“After they prayed, the place where they were meeting was shaken. And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and spoke the word of God boldly.”* (Acts 4:31NIV)
- Pray for believers to have confidence in God’s promises. *“So do not throw away your confidence; it will be richly rewarded.”* (Hebrews 10:35 NIV)

Nation

- Pray for unity and confidence among our national leaders. *“Have I not commanded you? Be strong and courageous. Do not be afraid; do not be discouraged, for the Lord your God will be with you wherever you go.”* (Joshua 1:9 NIV)
- Pray for the leaders and people in our nation to place their confidence in God’s guidance. *“Blessed is the nation whose God is the Lord, the people he chose for his inheritance.”* (Psalm 33:12 NIV)
- Prayer for strength and stability in governance. *“He will be the sure foundation for your times, a rich store of salvation and wisdom and knowledge; the fear of the Lord is the key to this treasure.”* (Isaiah 33:6 NIV)



Day 38: Wed 14 February 2024

Theme: Awesome God, Consuming Fire

Devotional thought by Ps. Arthur Were

Songs: Consuming Fire by Tim Hughes, We speak to Nations by Lakewood

Sometimes, we may become complacent and carry a sense of pride in who we are and what we have achieved. You might feel like, *"I have now learned to pray, what else is there for me to do?"*, or you might say, *"I know the bible, what else is there to learn?"* Such seasons are dangerous because we can easily become self-reliant. Maybe things are going well for you, and you have everything that you need (a nice home, good relationship, enviable job, and a weighty bank account etc) and yet you could also be on a slippery slope in your spiritual life. Humanly speaking, when life is good, God is usually relegated to the back seat of our lives, and we forget that He is the one who gave us these blessings to enjoy.

What He will do sometimes is orchestrate a series of events that will cause you to long for Him once again. He will place you in circumstances that will purify you as He works within your hearts. He will awaken you once again to the importance of total dependence on Him. What is He doing? Purifying you with His consuming fire of repentance. Job went through such an experience where he just did not know what was happening. In the end though, Job concluded, *"My ears had heard of you but now my eyes have seen you. Therefore, I despise myself and repent in dust and ashes..."* (Job 42:5-6). When God hears such a response, then He has won you back. So, allow Him to consume you this season so you can be made holy.

Additional Scriptures: 1 Peter 1:6-7, 2 Timothy 2:20-21, 1 Timothy 2:1-8

Prayer Direction

Personal & Family

- Ask God for a broken and contrite heart so that you and your family can live in total repentance. *“Repent ye therefore, and be converted, that your sins may be blotted out, when the times of refreshing shall come from the presence of the Lord.”* (Acts 3:19)
- Pray for pure motives in all you do. *“Search me, God, and know my heart; test me and know my anxious thoughts. See if there is any offensive way in me and lead me in the way everlasting.”* (Psalm 139:23-24)
- Ask God for a desire to depend on Him in prayer and His word. *“Elijah was a human being, even as we are. He prayed earnestly that it would not rain, and it did not rain on the land for three and a half years. Again he prayed, and the heavens gave rain, and the earth produced its crops.”* (James 5:17)

Church

- Pray for a willingness among believers to live godly lives. *“Do not conform to the pattern of this world but be transformed by the renewing of your mind. Then you will be able to test and approve what God’s will is—his good, pleasing, and perfect will.”* (Romans 12:2)
- Pray for boldness to turn away from sin and satanic altars. *“Come near to God and he will come near to you. Wash your hands, you sinners, and purify your hearts, you double-minded. Grieve, mourn and wail. Change your laughter to mourning and your joy to gloom. Humble yourselves before the Lord, and he will lift you up.”* (James 4:8-10)

Nation

- Pray for godly decision-making among our leaders. *“Commit to the LORD whatever you do, and he will establish your plans.”* (Proverbs 16:3)
- Pray for the fear of the Lord fill the hearts of the people in our nation. *“The fear of the LORD is the beginning of wisdom, and knowledge of the Holy One is understanding.”* (Proverbs 9:10)



Day 39: Thur 15 February 2024

Theme: Awesome God, Our Reconciler

2 Corinthians 5:18-19

“All this is from God, who reconciled us to himself through Christ and gave us the ministry of reconciliation: that God was reconciling the world to himself in Christ, not counting people’s sins against them. And he has committed to us the message of reconciliation.”

To reconcile means ‘to restore a relationship or bring harmony between parties who were previously estranged or in conflict’. In a spiritual sense, it refers to resolving the enmity between sinful man and God. Through Christ’s sacrifice, God offers reconciliation to all who believe, restoring us to fellowship with Him.

Today, our society is characterised by division and fragmentation; the importance of reconciliation cannot be overstated. It is a critical aspect of our personal connections, family dynamics, professional environments, and the broader communities, where disagreements and misunderstandings are common. Fortunately, God offers us a path to reconciliation, one that promises hope and healing even amidst strife. As individuals, parents, professionals, and industry leaders, we can embody God’s reconciling love by striving for peace, practicing forgiveness, and seeking understanding in all our interactions with others. This way, we can contribute to a more unified and connected world.

Prayer Direction

Personal

- Pray for personal reconciliation with God. *“For if, while we were God’s enemies, we were reconciled to him through the death of his Son, how much more, having been reconciled, shall we be saved through his life!” (Romans 5:10 NIV)*
- Pray for healing and reconciliation in your relationships. *“Be kind and compassionate to one another, forgiving each other, just as in Christ God forgave you.” (Ephesians 4:32 NIV)*
- Pray for spiritual renewal and restoration. *“Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, the new creation has come: The old has gone, the new is here!” (2 Corinthians 5:17 NIV)*

Family

- Pray for healing from past hurts and restoration of trust among family members. *“Whoever would foster love covers over an offense, but whoever repeats the matter separates close friends.” (Proverbs 17:9 NIV)*
- Pray for reconciliation and unity within families. *“How good and pleasant it is when God’s people live together in unity!” (Psalm 133:1 NIV)*
- Pray for strength to extend grace and forgiveness to those in need. *“Bear with each other and forgive one another if any of you has a grievance against someone. Forgive as the Lord forgave you.” (Colossians 3:13 NIV)*

Church

- Pray for believers to walk in humility and love among each other. *“Finally, all of you, be like-minded, be sympathetic, love one another, be compassionate and humble.” (1 Peter 3:8 NIV)*
- Pray for restoration and healing in the body of Christ. *“Instead, speaking the truth in love, we will grow to become in every respect the mature body of him who is the head, that is, Christ.” (Ephesians 4:15-16 NIV)*
- Pray for unity and reconciliation among believers. *“I appeal to you, brothers and sisters, in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that all of you agree with one another in what you say and that there be no divisions among you, but that you be perfectly united in mind and thought.” (1 Corinthians 1:10 NIV)*

Nation

- Pray for reconciliation and peace between nations. *“He will judge between the nations and will settle disputes for many peoples. They will beat their swords into plowshares and their spears into pruning hooks. Nation will not take up sword against nation, nor will they train for war anymore.” (Isaiah 2:4 NIV)*
- Pray for healing and reconciliation in divided communities. *“He heals the brokenhearted and binds up their wounds.” (Psalm 147:3 NIV)*
- Pray for wisdom and unity in government. *“For lack of guidance a nation falls, but victory is won through many advisers.” (Proverbs 11:14 NIV)*
