Job Purpose.

To implement discipleship and Family life interventions at household and community level, equipping individuals and caregivers with biblical values, life skills, and practical tools to build strong families and support holistic community transformation.

Key Responsibility Areas.

1. Implement structured discipleship sessions using the approved curriculum.
2. Lead Bible studies, life skills sessions, mentorship, and small group activities to support spiritual growth.
3. Identify spiritual gaps and guide mothers in personal spiritual to foster spiritual transformation with targeted interventions.
4. Participate in Campus planning and meetings for alignment to the church program.
5. Provide family life and psychosocial support to mothers and children in collaboration with Integrated Case Workers train mothers on values-based guidance.
6. Promote positive discipline and healthy relationships within households and communities.
7. Conduct psychosocial support home visits to the mothers.
8. Support in the mobilisation and training of volunteers to deliver discipleship and family life programme activities.
9. Mobilise community members for discipleship, outreach, and family life activities.
10. Support monitoring and evaluation activities through data to track outcomes.
11. Support update of databases and records on programme activities.
12. Prepare periodic reports on discipleship and family life activities.
