### Job Purpose.

To support and implement livelihood initiatives at the Centre level by equipping mothers to access skilling opportunities and support to achieve sustainable income, savings, and economic resilience.

### Key Responsibility Areas.

1. Support in the identification and enrolment of the mothers onto the livelihoods program.
2. Conduct the mother's selection assessment as per established criteria and skills needs evaluation.
3. Implement and deliver livelihood activities.
4. Support the implementation of structured mentorship activities within the livelihood programme.
5. Coordinate building and training initiatives for mothers to deliver programme activities effectively.
6. Provide basic follow-up support to community volunteers during programme implementation.
7. Support mothers to access employment, apprenticeship opportunities, financial institutions, and services.
8. Coordinate the linkage of mothers to available opportunities, markets, and resources.
9. Participate in selected district-level government and partner engagements when required.
10. Maintain working relationships with partners to support livelihood activities.
11. Support the establishment, strengthen networking efforts, and collaborate with partners.
12. Maintain accurate records and submit timely periodic reports.

- Must have knowledge of the local language.
- A committed, consistent, and disciplined Christian who demonstrates spiritual maturity and active engagement in discipleship, aligned with Watoto values.
