### Key Responsibilities Areas.

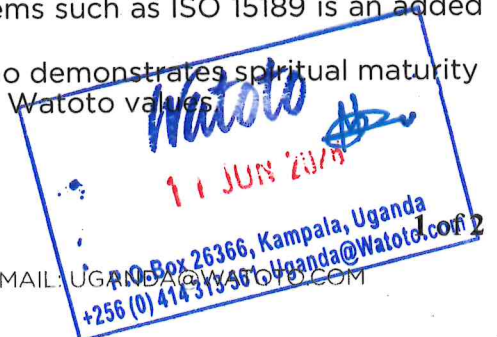
- Prepare samples and conduct laboratory tests according to standard operating procedures in the areas of serology, hematology, immunology, and parasitology.
