Job Purpose.

Support with the day-to-day clinical activities within Baby Watoto, Gulu, to ensure the highest possible medical care.

Key Responsibility Areas.

5. Maintain accurate and up-to-date medical records and provide regular clinical updates on infants.
6. Participate in health programmes within and outside Watoto as and when a need arises.
7. Participate in colleague-led training to maintain a high standard of care and implement evidence-based education and practice.
8. Coordinate good health management and hygiene for the infants through regular health-related education to the general staff.
9. Assist nannies when other duties in general baby care.
10. Perform daily duties as allocated by Head Nurse.
