Key Duties and Responsibilities (but not limited to)

- To guide and advise village management on the best practises to promote discipline of Children.
- To advise mothers on how best to discipline their children as informed by the Child Protection Policy and reports.
- To supervise and guide on the correction activities of children on suspension from school and empower disciplinary committees. Support with the reintegration of children who return from suspension.
- To provide the homes office and WISE with updated records regarding children's discipline.
- To conduct orientation to new children in the homes.
- To implement, monitor and assess Early Childhood Development programs, activities and initiative.
- To make follow ups on Children remanded in government facilities or other institutions (police, court, prison, LCs, external schools, Hospitals) on discipline grounds.

Qualifications, Skills and Experience.

- At least two years' experience working with children in a similar role and a busy organisation.
