LET'S DISCUSS

1. What kinds of people did Jesus say
we should care for?
*(People who are hungry, thirsty, strangers,
need clothes, sick, in prison and anyone
who needs help.)*
2. Why were the people surprised when
Jesus said they had helped Him?
*(They didn't know they were helping Jesus.
Caring for others means caring for Jesus.)*
3. What does this story teach us about
caring for others?
*(We should notice when people need help
and we help them because we are doing
it for Jesus.)*
4. Who is one person in your community
you can care for this week, and what
can you do for them?

CARE IN ACTION

- Let the children pair up.
- One person will remove their shoe
and place it between them.
- Call out different actions like touch
your head, knees, toes... but when
you say, grab the shoe, whoever
grabs it gets to pick a paper from
the box called "Situations".
- Situations are: Child is sad, Child forgot their
lunch, Mum is angry, Friend failed test,
Jajja is sick, a new child at school.
- Once you pick it, together with your friend,
share how you would care for that person.

*Lesson: Caring isn't just something
we talk about. Caring is something
we DO!*
