SCRIPTURE

“Don’t let anyone look down on you because you are young, but set an example for the believers in speech, in conduct, in love, in faith and in purity.”  
1 Timothy 4:12 NIV

OBSERVATION

You may be young, but God can still use you to shine His light. People are watching, not to judge you, but to learn from you. Your words, your kindness, your choices, and your faith can show others what it means to follow Jesus. When you live like Jesus, people might want to know Him too!

APPLICATION

## MONDAY

### Speech- Watch Your Words

**Read Ephesians 4:29-** *"Do not let any unwholesome talk come out of your mouths, but only what is helpful for building others up according to their needs, that it may benefit those who listen."*

**Reflection:** Our words can build up or break down. When you speak kindly, people feel loved—and they might wonder what makes you different.

**Challenge:** Speak 3 kind or helpful words today. Can you say something nice even when you're annoyed?

## WEDNESDAY

### Love- Love Like Jesus

**Read John 15:12-** *"My command is this: Love each other as I have loved you."*

**Reflection:** Love isn't just for people who are easy to love. When you love like Jesus, people see a different kind of love—the kind that changes hearts.

**Challenge:** Choose to love someone who's hard to love—pray for them or do something kind.

## THURSDAY

### Faith- Keep Believing and Trusting

**Read Proverbs 3:5-** *"Trust in the Lord with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding."*

**Reflection:** Faith means trusting God even when you don't have all the answers. Your trust in Him can encourage others to trust Him too.

**Challenge:** When you feel unsure today, stop and say, "I trust You, Jesus."

## TUESDAY

### Conduct- Let Them See Jesus in You

**Read Matthew 5:16-** *"In the same way, let your light shine before others, that they may see your good deeds and glorify your Father in heaven."*

**Reflection:** Actions speak louder than words. People will notice when you do the right thing, and that might lead them to Jesus.

**Challenge:** Do something good without being asked—help clean, share, or say sorry.



## FRIDAY

### Purity- Stay Pure

**Read Psalm 51:10-** *"Create in me a pure heart, O God, and renew a steadfast spirit within me."*

**Reflection:** Purity isn't just about staying out of trouble—it's about choosing what pleases God. A pure heart shines bright for Jesus.

**Challenge:** Ask God to help you clean out anything wrong in your thoughts, actions, or habits.
