


"By faith Noah, when warned about things not yet seen, in holy fear built an ark to save his family." Hebrews 11:7 NIV

Faith is My Superpower to Believe

Hebrews 11:1 says, "Now faith is confidence in what we hope for and assurance about what we do not see."

Reflection: Faith is believing God is real and keeps His promises—even when we can't see Him. Just like we trust the wind even though we can't see it, we can trust God because we see His work all around us.

Challenge: Look for one thing today that reminds you God is real—like the sun, a smile, or answered prayer—and say, "I believe in You, God!".

WEDNESDAY

Faith is My Superpower to Stand Strong
1 Corinthians 16:13, "Be on your guard; stand firm in the faith; be courageous; be strong."

Reflection: Faith helps us stay strong when others may laugh at us or when it's tough to do what's right. With faith, we don't have to give in to fear or pressure

Challenge: Think of one way you can stand strong today—like telling the truth, being kind, or saying no to something wrong—and do it with courage.

THURSDAY

Faith is My Superpower to Pray

"If you believe, you will receive whatever you ask for in prayer." Matthew 21:22

Reflection: Faith makes our prayers powerful. When we pray, we are not just talking to the air—we're talking to God who listens and answers. Prayer plus faith is like activating our superpower.

Challenge: Pray for one specific thing today (big or small) and trust God with it. Write it down and watch how He answers.

TUESDAY

Faith is My Superpower to Trust

Proverbs 3:5 says, "Trust in the Lord with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding."

Reflection: Faith means trusting God's way is always best, even when we don't understand. Sometimes things feel confusing or hard, but God knows the plan. Trust is choosing to follow Him anyway.

Challenge: When something feels hard today, pause and pray: "God, I trust You with this.



FRIDAY

Faith is My Superpower to Grow

"Faith comes from hearing the message, and the message is heard through the word about Christ."

Romans 10:17

Reflection: Faith is like a muscle—the more we use it, the stronger it gets. Reading the Bible, praying, and listening to God's Word helps our faith grow bigger every day.

Challenge: Read one Bible verse today (ask a parent, leader, or sibling if you need help) and say, "This is growing my faith!
