OBSERVATION

## MONDAY

God Gives a Big Job

Read *Nehemiah 2:17*

**Reflection:** Nehemiah saw a big problem; the wall of Jerusalem was broken. Instead of worrying, he trusted God and made a plan. Leaders don't do big jobs alone; they need a team.

**Challenge:** Today, notice something around you that needs help; maybe your room, a class project, or a friend. Think: *Who can I help so we can fix it together?*


## WEDNESDAY

Encourage Each Other

Read *Nehemiah 4:6*

**Reflection:** Even when things were hard, Nehemiah encouraged everyone to keep going. He reminded them that they could do it together. Leaders lift up their team instead of complaining.

**Challenge:** Say something kind or encouraging to someone today. Tell a teammate or friend, "You can do this!" Watch how it makes their day brighter.

## TUESDAY

Everyone Has a Job

Read *Nehemiah 3:1*

**Reflection:** Nehemiah didn't rebuild the wall alone. Everyone had a part to play. Some worked on the gates, some on the walls, each person helped in their own way. Teams work best when everyone does their part.

**Challenge:** Today, help someone with their job or task; maybe a friend with schoolwork, a sibling with chores, or a teammate in a game. Notice how small help makes a big difference.

## THURSDAY

Protect Each Other

Read *Nehemiah 4:17*

**Reflection:** Rebuilding the wall was dangerous. Everyone helped and protected each other. Teamwork is not just working together; it's looking out for one another too.

**Challenge:** Be aware of someone who might need help today; protect or support them. Maybe help a younger child safely cross the road, stand up for a friend, or help carry something heavy.

## FRIDAY

Celebrate Teamwork

Read *Nehemiah 6:15*

**Reflection:** When everyone worked together, the wall was finished! God sees teamwork, and He blesses it. Leaders know that success comes when everyone's efforts are combined.

**Challenge:** Celebrate your team! Thank a friend, classmate, or family member for helping you this week. Maybe draw a "thank you" card or say a prayer for them.
