### 1 Peter 4:10

When the corona-virus struck China earlier this year, millions of people fled or were quarantined, as fear spread across China to the world. One group of people, however, had a different response. Some Christians in the city of Wuhan—the virus' epicenter—went into the streets distributing face masks, passing out Gospel brochures, and sharing the message of Jesus.
